Our current League Coordinator will train the substitute prior to any substitution shifts. This position involves managing the day-to-day of our Winter and Spring Jr. NBA leagues, focused on fun, skill development, and enriching experiences for young athletes. The ideal candidate will foster a positive environment where kids can learn and grow through basketball, emphasizing confidence, teamwork, and fun. This position would be ideal for someone who needs minimal hours but enjoys direct coaching with children.

Position Requirements

Winter & Spring Basketball League Seasons:

- Referee basketball league games for kids 5-11 years old following NECC's league rules.
- Oversee league operations, including game day setup, scorekeeping, and resolving any issues that arise. Move teams along for each game and keep score or assigning a parent score keeper.
- Promote good sportsmanship, teamwork, and a love of the game among all participants.
- Maintain accurate records of player registrations, game results, and other relevant information.

- Foster a positive, inclusive, and encouraging environment for all participants.
- Strong understanding of basketball rules, techniques, and strategies.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills; ability to effectively communicate with children, parents, and volunteers.
- Knowledge of safety practices related to youth sports and the ability to ensure a safe playing environment.
- Able to support youth, adapt to different learning styles and build long-term relationships with families
- Able to maintain confidentiality.
- Experienced with office technology & software, including Word, Excel & Outlook (or Google equivalent), and comfortable and confident navigating new technology
- Demonstrate awareness of others' social identities (e.g., race, gender, disability status, religion, etc.) and understands their relevance in the workplace and NECC programs and activities

- Previous experience coaching youth basketball, is required.
- Encouraged but not required:
 - A background in sports management, education, physical education, or a related field is preferred.
 - Bilingual (Spanish preferred)
 - Life experience as Black, Indigenous, or Person of Color, LGBTQIA2S+, or any persons identifying as a member of a marginalized community
